LBHA Updates: The LBHA staff provided <u>updates</u> within the department. Andrea also announced that there are budget cuts to be expected for grant funded services and to begin to prepare for what programs might be able to be cut over others. It is potential for this year but almost guaranteed for FY26. Our hope is to let the state know where cuts can be made based on low performance and lack of need.

Data Presentation- Gap Analysis: Andrea gave a presentation on the <u>Gap Analysis</u> completed in April 2024 by the LBHA Advisory Council to educate local providers about what resources and services we currently have in Calvert and where we see gaps in services that we will focus our efforts on in future strategic planning.

Resource Presentation- Ueno Health's Prosper App: Eric Sullivan presented on the <u>Prosper App</u> which is geared towards youth wellness and selfcare. The app is free, and Ueno provides technical assistance and presentations for any local provider interested in learning more.
