

# Attention Parents:

## **School Vaccine Requirements for**

Kindergarten through 6<sup>th</sup> Grade

And

7<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> Grade

- **Kindergarten through 6<sup>th</sup> Grade students** need proof of two Varicella (Chickenpox) vaccines.
- **7<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> Grade students** will need proof of MCV4 (Meningococcal) and Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis/whooping cough) vaccines.



A parent or guardian **MUST** confirm that an appointment has been made for ANY school required vaccine by the first day of school August 31, 2021. If the child has **NOT** received the required vaccines by the 20<sup>th</sup> day after school starts, the child will be excluded from school.

Calvert County Health Department is offering two FREE vaccination clinics for the following students:

**KINDERGARTEN** through **6<sup>th</sup> GRADERS** who are required to have two doses of chicken pox vaccine **and** **SEVENTH** through **12<sup>th</sup> GRADERS** who are required to have one dose of Tdap and one dose of Meningococcal vaccine for the 2021 school year.

There will be **APPOINTMENT ONLY** clinics at the Health Department on:

- **WEDNESDAY** September 8<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm

**AND**

- **Wednesday** Sept. 15<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm

**Varicella, Tdap, and Meningococcal** vaccines will be given on a first come first serve basis and are **FREE** regardless of health insurance status. **MenB and HPV** vaccines will also be offered at no cost.
